

1. Tell us about the students who were in this case study.

Answer: 20 kindergarten students participated in this case study. Most come from a low income family, tested below grade level, and did not have any pre-k experience.

2. How did you use Alive Studios' resources with the children?

Answer: I used the Zoo Keeper ABC Boot Camp program with the morning meeting, show and tell, anchor charts, animal hats, handwriting page, printable letter book, augmented reality animal cards on my white screen, and the ABC Bootcamp Fashion Show.

I am also using the Animal a Week lessons by following the lesson plans. I follow the lessons printed in the book, but on day 5, I use the Letters alive Journals and Rugs alive.

3. What are the ELA Skills that you measured with your students to prove success in this Study?

Answer: I used the uppercase and lowercase identification assessment and letter sound assessment.

4. Overall, how did you and the students like Alive Studios' supplemental resources?

Answer: My students loved the 3D animals and the noises they made. They especially loved the sentence building with the animal cards.

5. What was your favorite aspect of the program? What were your students' favorites?

Answer: I believe my favorite was the same as the students. I loved the interactive sentence building with the animal cards to see if they can swim, walk, play, etc.

6. Why do you think the program was so successful for your learners?
